The Extended Program Assistant is responsible for on-site daily operations and implementation of the daily program. The ideal candidate will provide leadership and supervision to students, serve as a positive Christian role model, and maintain an organized, clean, and safe learning and recreational environment.

Job Responsibilities

- Oversee an after-school care classroom of mixed age students; supervise students during homework time and afternoon snack.
- Plan daily devotion and learning activities such as games and gym time.
- Maintain a classroom environment where all students can learn and thrive.
- Oversee volunteers and classroom assistants.
- Mentor, coach, and guide them during the after-school hours.
- Give students opportunities to grow and lead by providing feedback and coaching to develop the next generation of Christian leaders.
- Shepherd students under your care. Maintain godly character both within and outside the classroom, build positive relationships with students, engage in intentional conversations and activities, and discipline students in a God-honoring way.
